Examples might include an employer, a program manager, an individual with whom she volunteers, etc. The Personal reference **should not be a peer of the applicant**.

The Academic reference letter should be written by someone who an applicant knows through school, such as a teacher, counselor, coach, etc. The person writing this academic reference letter **should not be a fellow student**.
